

RegALE: Regional capacity for Adult Learning and Education

RegALE aims to increase impact and sustainability of regional/local adult education (AE) organisations by setting up or reinforcing networks among them and with regional/local authorities.

The most significant project **outcome** will be an increase of the partners' capacity (and of their target groups/members) to respond to their challenges, to build cooperation structures, and promote an adult education culture in cities/regions.

The project milestones are:

- Background report on the challenges and opportunities of AE in cities/regions
- Repository of good practices that promote a learning culture at local/regional levels
- Peer learning and capacity building activities
- Peer learning webinars
- Case studies to showcase the piloting experiences
- Road map to develop a learning region/city
- Policy recommendations for national and European policymakers
