

Train the Provider aims to address structural and operational differences in regard to staff training within the adult education sector. In an issue-based approach partners identified specific problems and topics from each organization's individual context and compared strategies in order to collectively work on solutions for common problems and extrapolate good practice examples.

The project milestones:

- Partners gained new perspectives and to found useful hands-on solutions for problems commonly facing providers of adult education training through exchange across national borders.
- The project established the basis for a European canon of benchmarks that will allow for comparison beyond the original consortium. These benchmarks will help local agents working in staff training for the adult education sector develop more efficient and sustainable planning strategies.
- Partners regularly involved external experts as well as target group representatives, who might profit from the results of the project and invited their input and feedback.
- An overarching goal was the intensification of exchange between umbrella
 organisations in the adult education sector across the EU, and cooperation
 between the partners will run beyond the project lifetime.
